**This Change Order Provides for:** Various fencing modifications throughout the project.

**Reason for change:** Various fencing modifications throughout the project are described below.

- Install 938 LF of WM fencing from Rt. "C" 27+42.26 to Lt. "E" 35+79.00 +/- (Cul-de-Sac to the Maintenance Access Road). The additional fence was installed to protect the County right-of-way and mitigation plantings through the future irrigation efforts during the plant establishment period.
- Delete BW fencing from Lt. "E" 15+13.35 to Lt. "C" 23+01.13. The property owner in this location requested that no fence be built. The property owner will install a new fence of their own type.
- The Bloxham fencing material changes included the installation of metal pipe posts in lieu of t-post at the request of the property owner.
- Remove tree stump Lt "B" 24+50 +/- . A tree stump along the right-of-way line in this location impeded the installation of the new permanent fencing. The stump was removed to allow the permanent fencing to be installed in the planned location and proper alignment.
- Install salvaged gates. 4 EA gates were installed to restrict public access beyond the County right-of-way. Installation of these gates will allow only authorized personnel to enter County property for future maintenance access purposes and to access the plant mitigation areas.
- Repair damaged fencing corner post. After the permanent fencing was completed, a fence post corner brace located Rt. "C" 26+30.00 was damaged by the public. The post and bracing was replaced to restore the new fence and maintain adequate exclusion to the adjacent property.

**Method of payment:** The payment for changes will be made for as an Increase in Contract Item at Contract Unit Price and Extra Work at Agreed Lump Sum. An independent analysis of the agreed lump sum price is on file in the project records.

**Time adjustment:**

Consideration of a time adjustment is deferred for the work described in the change order. The amount of time adjustment, if any, will be determined in accordance with Section 8-1.07, "Delays," of the Standard Specifications.
