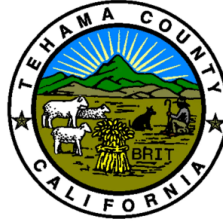

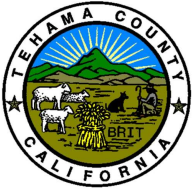

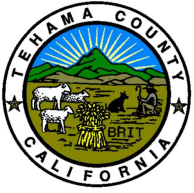
Groundwater Commission Supervisorial District representative terms have been revised to align with the Tehama County Board of Supervisor terms.
