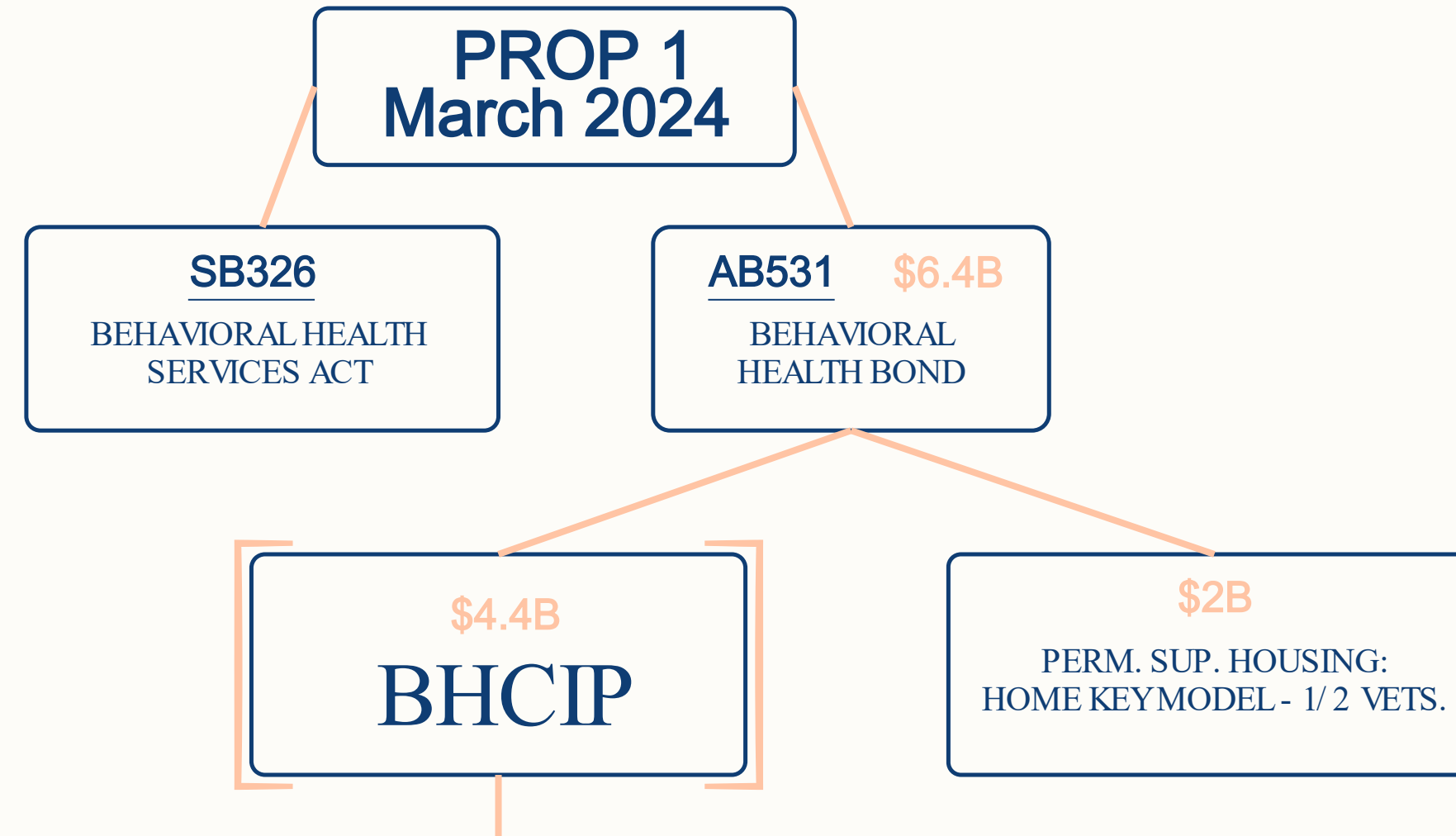

What the Campus Actually Is

“A clinical campus that provides every level of behavioral health care in one place.”

- Crisis Stabilization Unit (24-hour)
- Social Substance Use Detox
- Inpatient Psychiatric Hospital (acute)
- Subacute residential stabilization
- Short-Term Residential Facility (SRF)
- Step-down and aftercare coordination

Instead of the ER, jail, or out-of-county beds, people can stabilize locally and transition directly to the right level of care.

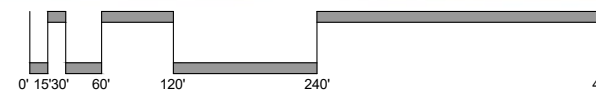

PER CITY OF SHASTA LAKE GIS ZONING MAP

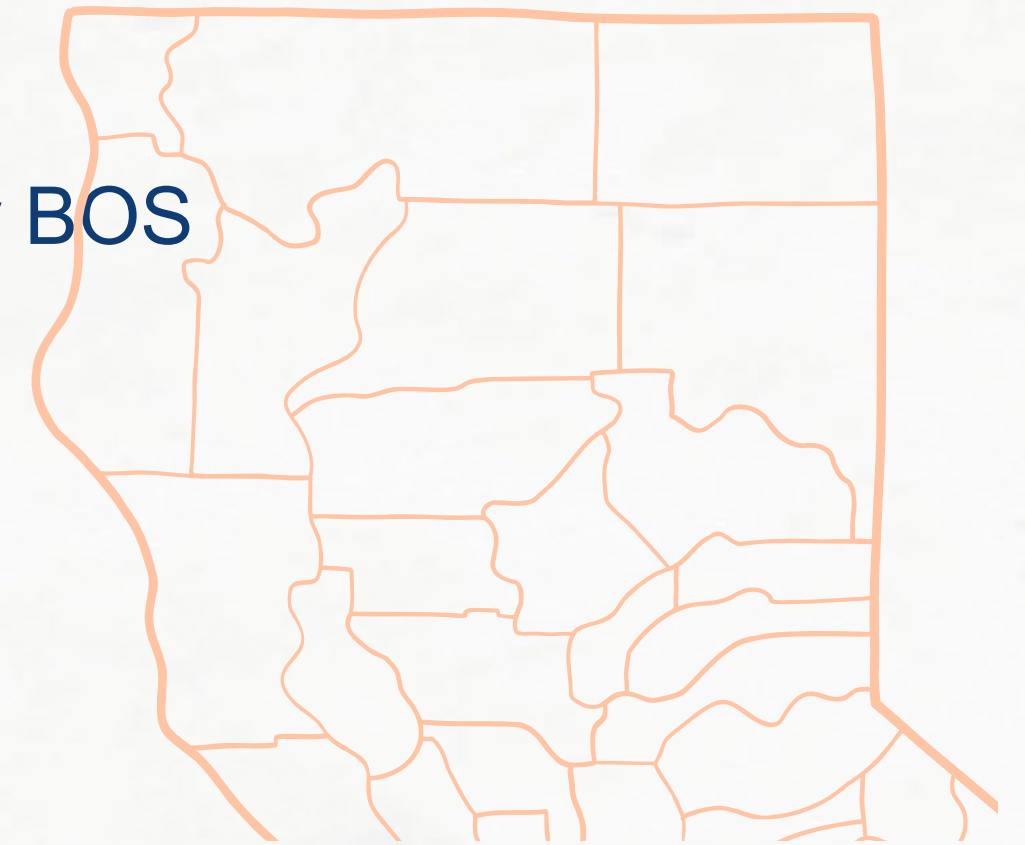

Why This Matters for the Rural North State

- Today, crisis care defaults to:
 - Emergency Department, jail, or long transport out of the area.
- The rural North State is facing critical workforce shortages and insufficient mental health and substance use disorder access.
- Transporting individuals hours away increases:
 - cost,
 - staff burden,
 - recidivism,
 - trauma for families,
 - and court-ordered treatment complications.

Campus Location: Current Status & Possible Options

- The grant application required the applicant to have site control over the location.
 - Written: City of Shasta Lake Location
- The project is currently in escrow on a property in the City of Shasta Lake; however, following the initial resistance by the Shasta County BOS
- Two alternative sites are on the table, if needed:
 - Shasta County—previously evaluated, but the owner was not interested, and is reconsidering
 - Tehama County—potential sites remain open for exploration
- We remain fully open to all location scenarios that best support the rural North State.
- A location change would require approval from the state.



69 Letters of Support Across the Rural North State

- County agencies, hospitals, tribal nations, law enforcement, behavioral health providers, and community organizations submitted 69 Letters of Support (LOS).
- LOS are not binding contracts—they signal to the State that counties are willing to participate and coordinate regionally.
- For the State, LOS demonstrates regional unity, readiness, and widespread recognition of the need.
- Tehama's early and consistent engagement helped build that momentum.



Behavioral Health Bed Needs Across the North State

After more than 200 stakeholder, partner and community engagements these are the top priority needs identified:

Emergency Room & Jail Diversion; Crisis Stabilization,

Substance Use Detox

Inpatient Access & High Acuity Youth Services

Additional Needs: Skilled Nursing, Mental Health Rehabilitation Centers, Youth Substance Use Treatment

Current Status & Next Steps

- BHCIP application submitted (October 2025).
- Property in escrow in the City of Shasta Lake (still exploratory).
- Environmental, planning, and community engagement processes are underway.
- Alternate locations remain possible depending on outcomes.
- State award expected: late Spring 2026.
- Post-award: detailed design → permitting → construction.
