**RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO LEVY AND COLLECT FISCAL YEAR 2026 (JULY 1, 2026
to JUNE 30, 2027) PARCEL CHARGES FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE WITHIN TEHAMA
COUNTY PERMANENT ROAD DIVISION NO. 0602
(BYWOOD DRIVE)**

WHEREAS under the provisions of the Permanent Road Division Law (Streets and Highways Code sections 1160 et seq.), the Board of Supervisors is authorized to establish one or more Permanent Road Divisions as a mechanism for providing road improvement and maintenance services within any portion of the unincorporated area;

WHEREAS Tehama County Permanent Road Division 0602 (Bywood Drive) was established by Resolution No. 35-2007 for the purpose of providing (and funding) ongoing road maintenance services for certain public roads located in the unincorporated area of Tehama County;

WHEREAS pursuant to Streets and Highways Code section 1179.5, the Board of Supervisors may fix and collect parcel charges (in accordance with the assessment ballot procedures in Government Code section 53753) within a Permanent Road Division to pay for the costs of the aforementioned road improvement and maintenance services;

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tehama Ordinance No. 1883 provides a procedure for fixing and collecting parcel charges for road maintenance services within Tehama County Permanent Road Division 0602 (Bywood Drive) on the tax roll;

WHEREAS a proposed budget prepared in accordance with Resolution No. 35-2007 and the Engineer's Report has been submitted to the Tehama County Board of Supervisors as an Exhibit incorporated into the attached Parcel Charge Report;

WHEREAS the notice of the public hearing was proper and timely and the public hearing was duly held;

WHEREAS the proposed budget does not increase the parcel charges beyond the level previously approved by the property owners in accordance with Article XIII D of the California Constitution (Prop. 218); and

WHEREAS the parcel charges are consequently in compliance with Prop.218, and no further mailed ballot proceedings are presently required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Tehama:

- (1) Accepts the attached Parcel Charge Report from the Director of Public Works.
- (2) Adopts the attached Parcel Charge Report from the Director of Public Works.
- (3) Adopts the parcel charges as set forth.
