

**AMENDMENT #1
TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE COUNTY OF TEHAMA
AND
COASTAL BUSINESS SYSTEMS, INC.**

This Amendment #1 to Agreement #2022-145 dated May 9, 2022, by and between the County of Tehama, through its Health Services Agency (County) and Coastal Business Systems, Inc. (Contractor) for the provision of the lease and maintenance of one multifunction device housed at 1850 Walnut St., Building G, Red Bluff, CA 96080, shall be amended as follows:

3. COMPENSATION

Contractor shall be paid in accordance with the rates set forth in this section, after satisfactorily completing the duties described in this Agreement.

A. County shall pay Contractor lease & maintenance payments of \$335.40, tax included per month for each month the multifunction device is useable by the County, for a maximum period of twelve (12) months.

B. Payment includes an all-inclusive maintenance agreement covering all parts, labor, service and supplies (excluding paper) for 3,000 monochrome pages, and 1,500 color pages, with overages read and billed quarterly at a rate of \$0.0065 per monochrome page and \$0.065 for color pages, plus tax.

C. The Maximum Compensation payable hereunder shall not exceed \$29,000.00 for the all-inclusive maintenance agreement.

D. Contractor shall not be entitled to payment or reimbursement for any tasks or services performed except as specified herein. Contractor shall have no claim against County for payment of any compensation or reimbursement, of any kind whatsoever, for any service provided by the Contractor after the expiration or other termination of this Agreement. Contractor shall not be paid any amount in excess of the Maximum Compensation amount set forth above, and Contractor

agrees that County has no obligation, whatsoever, to compensate or reimburse Contractor for any expenses, direct or indirect costs, expenditures, or charges of any nature by Contractor that exceed the Maximum Compensation amount set forth above. Should Contractor receive any such payment it shall immediately notify County and shall immediately repay all such funds to County. This provision shall survive the expiration or other termination of the Agreement.

It is mutually agreed that all other terms and conditions of Agreement #2022-145 shall remain in full force and effect.
