RE: Low Level Design – Hut Location Confirmation

As we move into the third and final phase of work under your CPUC Local Agency Technical Assistance (LATA) grant – the Low-Level Design phase, the work becomes much more project area specific. As discussed during our HLD to LLD Briefing (the Briefing) a few weeks ago, the work under this phase of the grant involves on-site field work and project area surveillance. The final product will be construction-ready, low-level network designs for slightly more than 40 miles of identified project area.

**A key piece of the design is the specific physical location of the hut(s) and cabinet(s).** The hut(s) and/or cabinet(s) house all the electronic systems associated with the local network. Possible hut locations were discussed during the Briefing and were shared with you via KMZ file following the Briefing so that you could share and confer with appropriate colleagues within your jurisdiction.

A Field Engineer has subsequently been on-site in the project area(s) and evaluated all the identified hut and/or cabinet location options. The following location(s) have been determined to be the best options.

By way of your signature below, you concur that this is a viable option for a hut and/or cabinet location(s) in your community(ies) and understand that the LATA Low Level Design will be designed using the above noted location(s). Redesigning the network to a different hut or cabinet location will not be possible under the LATA grant once this form has been submitted and design work has begun. Redesign will involve additional expense and effort. The County concurs these are viable options and does so prior to any lease and Franchise Fee agreements being put into place for the benefit of advancing the projects in the early phase. The County looks forward to continuing discussions with Golden State Connect Authority on lease terms for both parcels prior to applicability of Franchise Fees in perpetuity for both locations.
