

**AMENDMENT #1
TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE COUNTY OF TEHAMA
AND
COASTAL BUSINESS SYSTEMS**

This Amendment to Agreement #2020-167, dated August 19, 2020, by and between the County of Tehama, through its Health Services Agency (County) and Coastal Business Systems (Contractor) for the lease and maintenance of one (1) multifunction device, to be housed at 1860 Walnut St., Suite A, Red Bluff, CA shall be amended as follows:

3. COMPENSATION

Contractor shall be paid in accordance with the rates set forth in this section, after satisfactorily completing the duties described in this Agreement.

- A. County shall pay Contractor lease payments of \$161.25 per month for each month the multifunction device is useable by the County, for a maximum period of sixty (60) months.
- B. Additionally, County shall pay Contractor \$0.0065 per printed black and white image for maintenance and supplies for the multifunction device. Maintenance is billed monthly. There are no minimums on maintenance.
- C. The Maximum Compensation payable hereunder shall not exceed \$14,000.00 for the lease payments plus the actual number of copies made multiplied by the maintenance rate of \$0.0065 per copy.
- D. Upon conclusion of the sixty (60) month term, the County shall have the option to purchase the multifunction device for \$1.00.
- E. The foregoing amounts include all applicable sales taxes, use taxes and other taxes.
- F. Contractor shall not be entitled to payment or reimbursement for any tasks or services performed except as specified herein. Contractor shall have no claim against County for

payment of any compensation or reimbursement, of any kind whatsoever, for any service provided by the Contractor after the expiration or other termination of this Agreement. Contractor shall not be paid any amount in excess of the Maximum Compensation amount set forth above, and Contractor agrees that County has no obligation, whatsoever, to compensate or reimburse Contractor for any expenses, direct or indirect costs, expenditures, or charges of any nature by Contractor that exceed the Maximum Compensation amount set forth above. Should Contractor receive any such payment it shall immediately notify County and shall immediately repay all such funds to County. This provision shall survive the expiration or other termination of the Agreement.

It is mutually agreed that all other terms and conditions of Agreement #2020-167 shall remain in full force and effect.
