Reason for Change:

The plans show to install new roadside signs at various locations, however some of the signs were not included in the tabulated sign quantities. The Engineer requested and the Designer concurred with placing signs to demarcate the beginning and end of the bike lanes. A sign that was omitted needed to be added to a pedestrian barricade as were the street name signs on the mast arms at the traffic signal at Sister Mary Columba. Finally, the Engineer requested that temporary stop signs and hospital direction finding signs at Sister Mary Columba be placed during work to .
