IV. REGULAR ITEM

3. USE PERMIT #24-02; VERIZON WIRELESS - BEEGUM

25-1887

Director of Planning Jessica Martinez presented the item.

Chair Jones opened the Public Hearing.

In response to Commissioner Miranda, Director of Planning Jessica Martinez explained that no more than one cell tower may be present within 5 miles of another site.

Keith, a nearby resident, commented on a study regarding health effects associated with the proximity of cell towers. He further voiced his opposition to place a cell tower so close to a neighborhood.

A resident commented on her opposition to living near the proposed cell tower.

A resident commented on health effects of arc radiation and the impact on property values near cell tower sites. He further voiced his opposition to the proposed location of the cell tower.

Rob Burroughs commented on the need to install cell towers in remote areas to improve emergency communications.

Tom Husky voiced his opposition to the proposed cell tower site and shared concerns

about the impact the cell tower may have on his property value.

A resident commented on the public noticing procedure and explained that she did not receive advance notification about this hearing, despite owning property near the proposed site. She further voiced her opposition to the cell tower site.

A resident commented on the poor cell service she experiences in the proposed site and recognized the need to improve emergency communications for rural communities.

A resident voiced his concerns about possible health impacts due to proximity to cell towers. He further commented on impacts to property values near cell tower sites. Additionally, he provided his experience with emergency communications as a volunteer firefighter at the Bowman station.

Sherrie Rowels commented about her family's experience with adverse health effects. She further voiced her opposition to the location of the proposed cell tower.

A resident voiced his opposition to the location of the proposed cell tower due to the proximity of houses and school bus stops.

In response to Commissioner Patrick, Chris Roth, the applicant's representative, explained that the proposed location was selected because it would function as a "bridge" to support communication with nearby towers. He added that Verizon had been unable to find any viable alternative sites for the installation. Mr. Roth also addressed studies concerning the potential health impacts of long-term exposure to cellular towers.

Director of Planning Jessica Martinez provided information on the public notice process.

In response to Commissioner Martinez, Director of Planning Jessica Martinez acknowledged the need to provide mapping of other towers in the proposed site, and said she would provide a map to Commissioners for their review.
