# Summary

- **Rule Effective July 1, 2011**
- **Rule 2:11D is designed to reduce indirect sources of emissions.**
- **July 1, 2012, The District began implementation at 50% rate**
- **January 1, 2021, The District began implementation at 100% rate**
- **Fees are separated into two accounts  
Ozone precursors and PM pollution.**

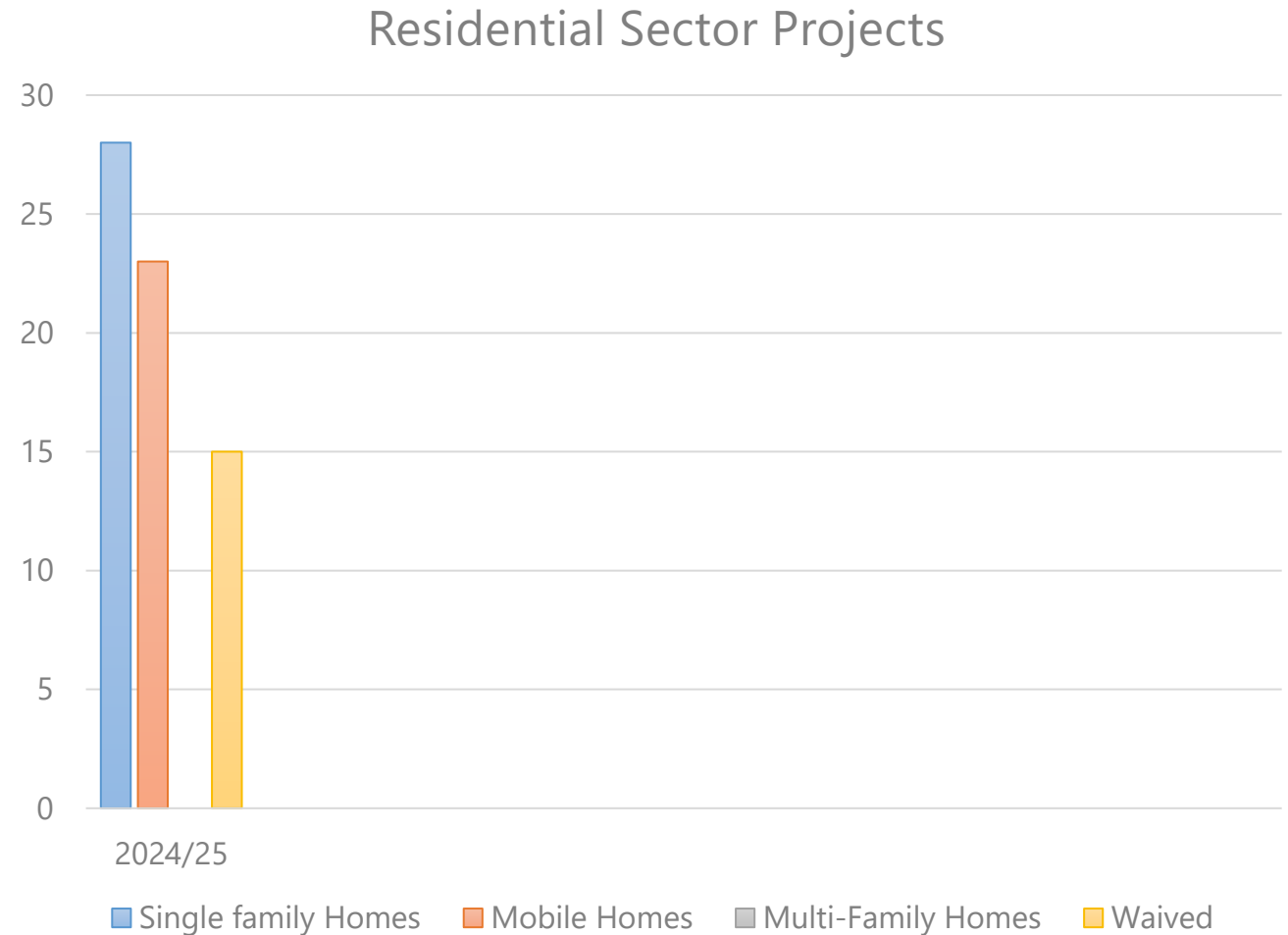

# Fees Received-Residential Sector

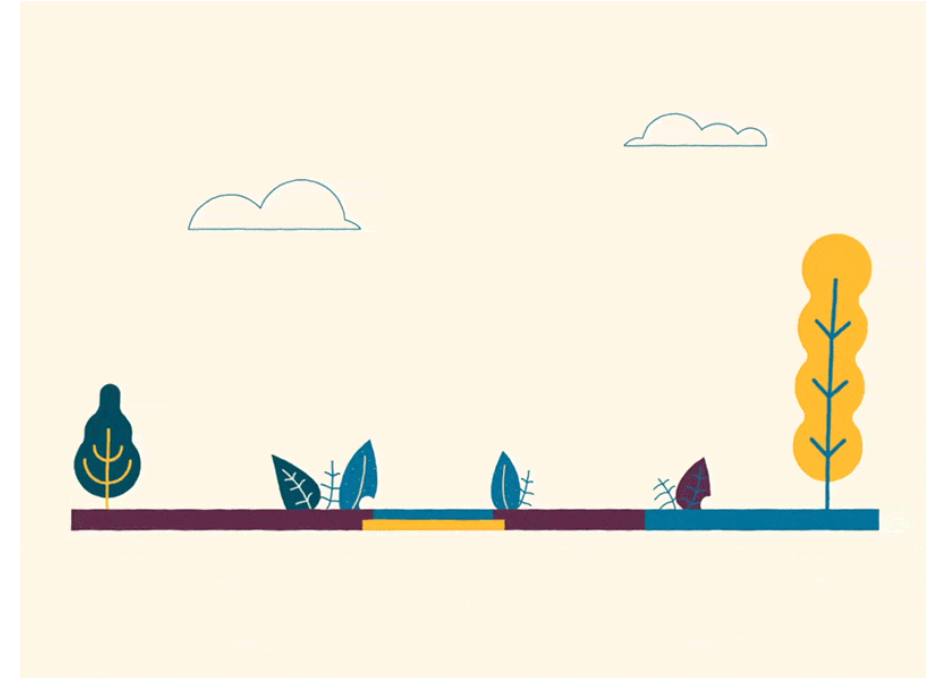
- **For fiscal year 2024/25 the District Received a total of 61 applications.**
- **The application breakdown was as follows:**
  - **38 Single family homes**
  - **23 Mobile homes**
  - **0 Multi-family Homes**
  - **15 fees waived**

- The District Collected \$17,034.5 in fees.

- **1 retail projects**



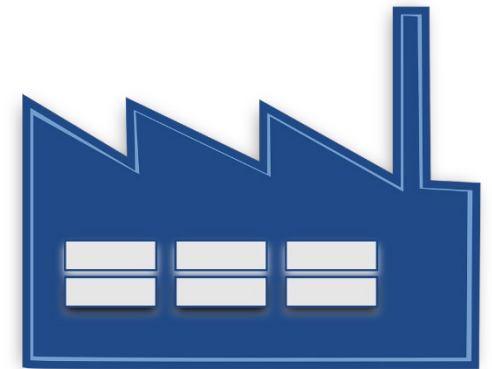

- **The District Collected \$7,563.91 in interest.**



# Total Funds Available

- **Total available balance in the ozone account is \$201,296**
- **Total Available Balance in the PM account is \$106,096**
- **Total: available: 356,343**

# Overall cost-effectiveness factor for funded projects.

- **2:11D funded the voluntary replacement of 20 non-certified wood stoves in Tehama county. Cost effectiveness of the funding was \$1,811.59 per ton. Reducing PM10 emissions by .69 tons per year.**
- **This project also benefits Tehama County by reducing PM2.5, CO, NOx and VOCs.**

- **The District received on response to our RFP in 2025, the project was selected and will reduce particulate emissions from an orchard tear out.**



# RPF Solicitation.

**The District is to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) each year requesting proposals to fund Ozone Precursor and Particulate Matter reduction projects.**

**Funds are available in both the ozone and pm accounts to fund a modest project or several small projects.**

**The District recommends that the RFP is published at the start of the 26/27 fiscal year once the budgeting process is complete.**
