current salary and wages. Mrs. Alexander reviewed the differences between stipends and wages.

Supervisor Moule said this ship has sailed, as we started this a long time ago and we agreed to have these discrepancies investigated.

Discussion took place regarding department heads or elected officials.

County Counsel Margaret Long said there are positions listed in the charter as elected officials and those salary and wages cannot be changed during the term. The Controller is not an elected position and is added to the Auditor position and this ordinance is looking to provide a stipend for the additional job duties performed as a Controller for Tehama County

Supervisor Carlson said this is a work around the law and she can't support this increase.

Supervisor Nolen said a stipend is not what this is for and this is not a good way to do it.
