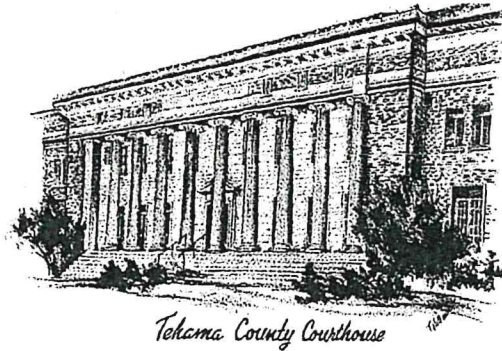

Dear Selection Committee Lead,

Tehama County Board of Supervisors supports the Resource Conservation District of Tehama County's (RCDTC) Emerson and Perry Riffle Side Channel Fish Passage Improvement Project for the Bureau of Reclamation's Central Valley Project Habitat & Facility Improvements.

Tehama County, located next to the Sacramento River, relies on the river, both economically and recreationally. As such, enhancing the habitat of the Chinook Salmon is important to our community and our rural way of life.

As continued drought conditions decrease precipitation, which causes lower flows and higher water temperatures, the winter run Chinook Salmon is increasingly threatened. The Sacramento River is a water delivery system managed by humans. In order to protect the species, restoration solutions managed by humans are required.
