



CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE CORNING UNION  
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Political Reform Act of 1974 (Government Code, § 81000 et. seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (Cal. Code Regs., tit.2, §18730) which contains the terms of a standard Conflict of Interest Code. It can be incorporated by reference, and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act.

Therefore, the terms of California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 18730 and any future amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference into this Code and along with the attachments in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitutes the Conflict of Interest Code of the Corning Union Elementary School District.

Designated employees shall file their statements with the Corning Union Elementary School District Superintendent's Office, which shall make and retain a copy and forward the original of the statements to the Election's Department.

**DESIGNATED POSITIONS AND  
DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES**

**Pursuant to Board Bylaws and Exhibits 9270 and  
Government Code Section 87300**

<b><u>Designated Positions</u></b>	<b><u>Disclosure Category</u></b>
1. Governing Board	1
2. Superintendent	1
3. Chief Business Official	1
4. Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services	1
5. Consultants	1

- Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code, subject to the following limitation:

The Superintendent may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position" is hired to perform a range of duties that are limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Superintendent's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code. Nothing herein excuses any such consultant from any other provision of the conflict of interest code.

**CORNING UNION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT  
CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE  
DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES FOR DESIGNATED POSITIONS**

**CATEGORY I**

All sources of income, interests in real property and investments and business positions in business entities located in or doing business in Tehama County, including gifts, loans, and travel payments.

**CATEGORY II**

All investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income, including gifts, loans, and travel payments, which provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of the type utilized by the Corning Union Elementary School District

**CATEGORY III**

All sources of income, investments, and business positions in business entities located in or doing business in Tehama County.

**CATEGORY IV**

Any income from any employee of the Corning Union Elementary School District, including gifts, loans, and travel payments.

**CATEGORY V**

All interested in real property.

All investments and business positions in any business entity located in or doing business in Tehama County or income from any source if the business entity or source of income manufactures or sells supplies, machinery, or equipment of the type utilized by the coming Union Elementary School District.

**All** investments and business positions in any business entity of income from any source if the business entity or source of income is a contractor or subcontractor engaged in the performance of work or services of the type utilized by the Corning Union Elementary School District.

**ATTACHMENT C**

**CORNING UNION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT CONFLICT  
OF INTEREST CODE  
PLACE OF FILING**

Pursuant to Government Code Section 87500, subdivisions (k) and (o), the Tehama County board of Supervisors, as the code reviewing body for the Corning Union Elementary School District has determined that the original Form 700- Statement of Economic Interests for each Designated Employee shall be filed with the Corning Union Elementary School District Office. The District shall provide a Form 700- Statement of Economic Interests to each Designated Employee annually and when that employee assumes or leaves any designated position.
