11.6 Special Pays

h. Officer-in-Charge Pay: An Officer-in-Charge (OIC) is defined as a Deputy Sheriff on patrol or a Correctional Deputy assigned to work in the jail, who is tasked with leading and giving direction to other deputies during a shift when a Sergeant, who would normally perform these leadership duties, is temporarily absent. Those deputies eligible for OIC pay will receive an additional five percent (5%) above their current base wage (hourly rate) while working in such capacity on an hour-for-hour basis.
