

TEHAMA COUNTY JUVENILE JUSTICE CENTER FENCE REPAIR

Suggested Findings

The Tehama County Board of Supervisors makes the following findings with regards to repair of the fence at the Tehama County Juvenile Justice Center:

1. That an emergency exists due to the damage and insufficiency of the fence at the Tehama County Juvenile Justice Center, located at 1790 Walnut Street, Red Bluff.
2. That the need for fence repair is a sudden and unexpected occurrence posing a clear and imminent danger to the health and safety of County personnel and juvenile wards during performance of essential services in the building.
3. That requirements of use within the Juvenile Justice Center will result in an unsafe and inoperative condition that cannot be mitigated without immediate repair of the fence.
4. That public health, safety, and convenience require immediate action to prevent or mitigate the threat to health, property, and essential public services.
5. That the emergency will not permit a delay resulting from a competitive solicitation for bids.
6. That authorizing approval for immediate repair of the fence at the Tehama County Juvenile Justice Center, without securing formal competitive bids, is necessary to respond to the emergency, and is in the best interests of the people of Tehama County.

Based on these findings, the Board of Supervisors concludes that the damage to the fence at the Tehama County Juvenile Justice Center constitutes an emergency under Public Contract Code sections 1102, 20134, and 22050 and Tehama County Code section 4.24.010(c), thereby allowing the Board to dispense with the formal competitive bid process.
